LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 856

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MYERSTOWN, LEBANON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE #808 AND THE AMENDMENTS THERETO, BY AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 15, PARTS 3 AND 4, RELATED TO STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING AND MUNICIPAL OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of Myerstown Borough, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, adopted Ordinance #808 in 2011, thereby regulating the stopping, standing, and parking of motor vehicles and traffic within Myerstown Borough and providing regulations for Municipal off-street parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds that it is in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of Borough residents to restrict parking along the east and west sides of North Railroad approaching the intersection with Route 422; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council desires to establish regulations for parking in spaces designated for charging a plug-in electric motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council wishes to adopt regulations for the parking lot at the Myerstown Community Center located along South Railroad Street; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council seeks to update information regarding the location of reserved spaces for Persons with Disability or Disabled Veterans; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council wishes to amend and clarify areas designated for parking during snow emergencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Myerstown, that the following provisions of Ordinance #808, and all amendments thereto, as set forth in the Myerstown Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15, shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Part 3 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Section 15-303 shall be amended to add the following location, at which parking shall be prohibited at all times:

Railroad Street, North	(a) east	(1) Main Avenue and Washington Avenue (2) a point 343 feet north of Jefferson Avenue and the intersection of north Railroad Street and Route 422
	(b) west	(1) a point 321 feet north of Jefferson Avenue and the intersection of north Railroad Street and Route 422

SECTION 2. Chapter 15, Part 3 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Section 15-306 shall be amended to state as follows:

§ 15-306. Reserved Spaces for Persons with Disability or Severely Disabled Veterans Established: Parking by Others Prohibited.

The Borough shall establish reserved spaces for persons with disability or severely disabled veterans upon application to and approval by Borough Council, in accordance with other Ordinances or Resolutions of the Borough related to the designation of such parking spaces. Parking in those spaces by persons other than a person with disability or severely disabled veteran is prohibited. Reserved spaces designated for this purpose shall be reviewed annually to determine continued need and confirm the total number of spaces reserved for this purpose within the Borough.

SECTION 3. Chapter 15, Part 3 – Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Section 15-309 shall be amended to state as follows:

§ 15-309. Electric Vehicle Charging Stations.

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle other than a plug-in electric motor vehicle within a parking space designated for charging a plug-in electric motor vehicle.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle in a parking space with a dedicated charging connector for plug-in electric motor vehicles for any purpose other than using the charging station to charge a plug-in electric motor vehicle.

[Current Section 15-309 shall be renumbered as Section 15-310, and current Section 15-310 shall be renumbered as Section 15-311.]

SECTION 4. Chapter 15, Part 4 – Municipal Off-Street Parking Facilities, Section 15-401 shall be amended to include the following additional municipal parking lot:

- I. Community Center Lot at the South Railroad Street Entrance.

SECTION 5. Chapter 15, Part 4 – Municipal Off-Street Parking Facilities, Section 15-402 shall be amended to include the following provision:

C. Community Center Lot at the South Railroad Street Entrance. Only visitors and guests of Myerstown Borough and other Community Center tenants shall be permitted to use this parking lot.

SECTION 6. Chapter 15, Part 4 – Municipal Off-Street Parking Facilities, Section 15-403 shall be amended to state as follows:

- A. During a time when there is a declared snow emergency in the Borough of Myerstown, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, there shall be no parking in Lot Number 2, located at 57 West Main Avenue.
- B. During a time when there is a declared snow emergency in the Borough of Myerstown, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, there shall be no parking until after snow has been cleared in the municipal parking lot on the west side of South Locust Street from Main Avenue to Madison Alley.
- C. There shall be no parking between the hours of 12:00 A.M. and 5:00 A.M. in Lot Number 1, located at 6 to 8 East Main Avenue, and in Lot Number 2, located at 57 West Main Avenue.
- D. During a time when there is a declared snow emergency in the Borough of Myerstown, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, Lot Number 1, located at 6 to 8 East Main Avenue, and the Swimming Pool Parking Lot may be used throughout the duration of the snow emergency.

SECTION 7. All other portions of Ordinance #808 and the amendments thereto, and Chapter 15 of the Myerstown Borough Code of Ordinances are hereby confirmed and ratified, and shall not be amended by this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of the Ordinance, it being the intent of the Borough that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of resolutions that are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and the same expressly are repealed.

SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall become effective _____, 2020.
